

Entrance Antiphon: How worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and divinity, and wisdom and strength and honour. To him belong glory and power for ever and ever.

Communion Antiphon: The Lord sits as King for ever. The Lord will bless his people with peace.



St. Andrew, apostle of Jesus, elder brother of St. Peter. The first one called by Jesus to be an apostle. Andrew preached around the shores of the Black Sea and throughout what is now Greece and Turkey. Andrew was martyred by crucifixion in Patras. He was crucified on an X-shaped cross or a "saltire." Today this is commonly referred to as "St. Andrew's Cross." He is the patron Saint of fishermen and of Scotland.

RORATE MASSES IN ADVENT AT THE CATHEDRAL: The first Rorate Mass will be on Saturday, December 9, 2023 at 6:45 AM and the second on December 16, 2023 at 6:45 AM. These Masses are celebrated in candlelight. They begin before the sun rises and end with the sun rising. This is to symbolize the light that is coming into the world when the Saviour, Jesus Christ is born. The Rorate Mass gets its name from the first line of the Entrance Antiphon: Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem." This translates as ""Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Savior." It is taken from the prophet Isaiah 45:8.

PHONE SYSTEM: The phone system for the offices is still being installed. We hope that, by the end of next week, all the mailboxes will be set-up for messages. I apologize for this inconvenience. PREAUTHORIZED DEBIT (PAD): Forms are available at the entrance to the Cathedral for the preauthorized debit program of giving. If you are interested, please fill one out as soon as you are able. You may put it in an envelope and place it in the offertory collection or you may send or hand it into the Parish Office.

<u>PUSH BARS AT CATHEDRAL CHURCH DOORS:</u> There are two doors that now have push (panic) bars at the Cathedral. One is located at the exterior front door nearest the stairs to the choir loft. The other is located at the side door that opens towards the Cathedral House. You will no longer feel the need to leave the church immediately after Mass but you can stay as long as you wish to pray. When you leave, you need only push the bar and the door will lock behind you.

<u>CHANGE IN MASS TIMES AT HOLY NAME:</u> Starting this week, the weekday Masses on Wednesday and Thursday at Holy Name will be celebrated at **10:00 AM**. Mass times on Monday and Tuesday remain at **7:00 PM**.
