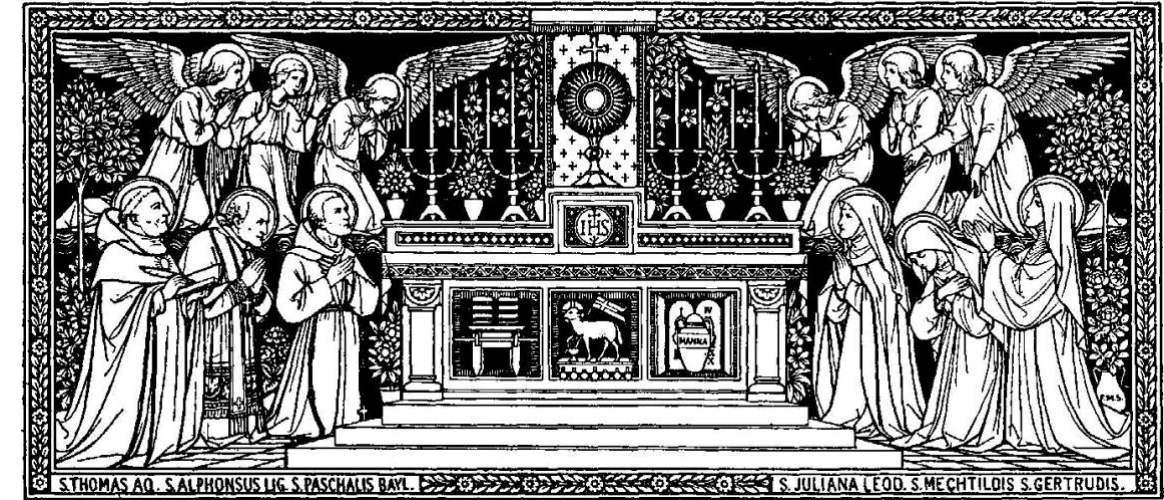

**Why do I need to go to Mass?** Jesus tells us in St. John’s Gospel that unless we eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood we shall not have life within us. You cannot receive His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity in Holy Communion at home. So important is the reception of the Lord and the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for our salvation, the Church requires us to attend Mass each Sunday and Holy Obligation. If we fail to do so, for no good reason, we commit mortal sin. If our life is seemingly out of control, if we have doubts, if we are struggling spiritually, we must never give up Sunday Mass. If we make Holy Mass on Sunday an absolute, no matter what, the Lord will never abandon us to the trials of this world and the devil.

**THE FEAST OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS:** Please note that Mass this Friday will be at 7:00 PM. After Mass, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the Litany of the Sacred Heart, and the prayer of consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will end with Benediction.

**THE FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY:** The Immaculate Heart of Mary is celebrated the day after the Feast Day of her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ's Sacred Heart. The heart is seen as a symbol of love and there is no doubt of the love that our Blessed Mother has for her children. Mass will be celebrated at 10:00 AM on Saturday. This Mass does not fulfill one's Sunday obligation.
