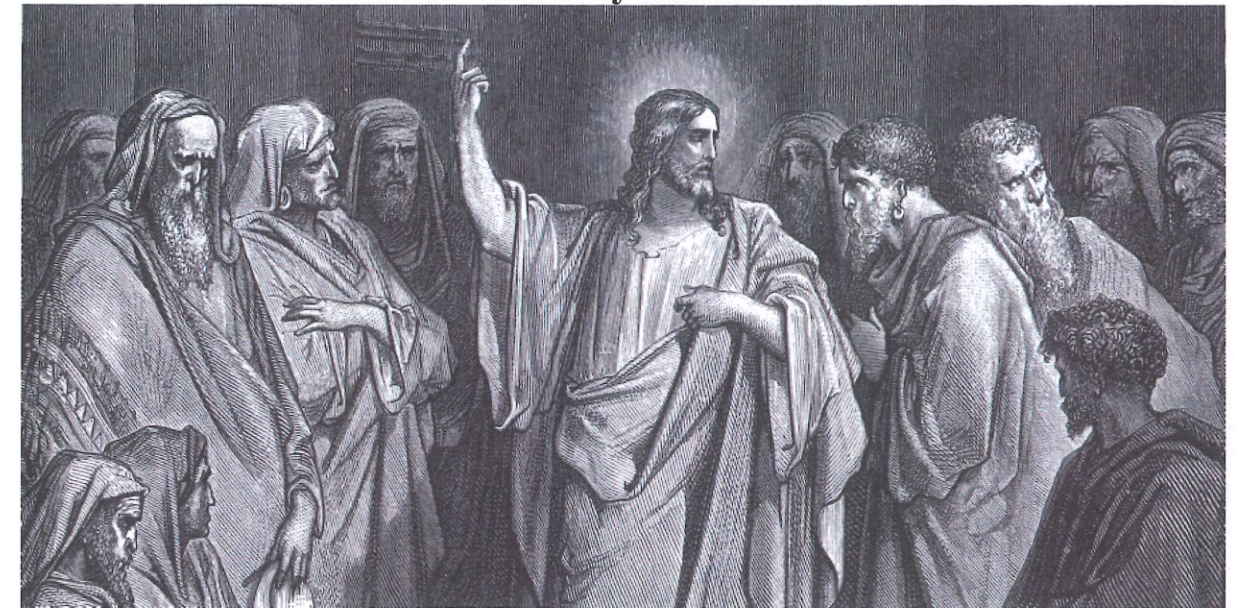

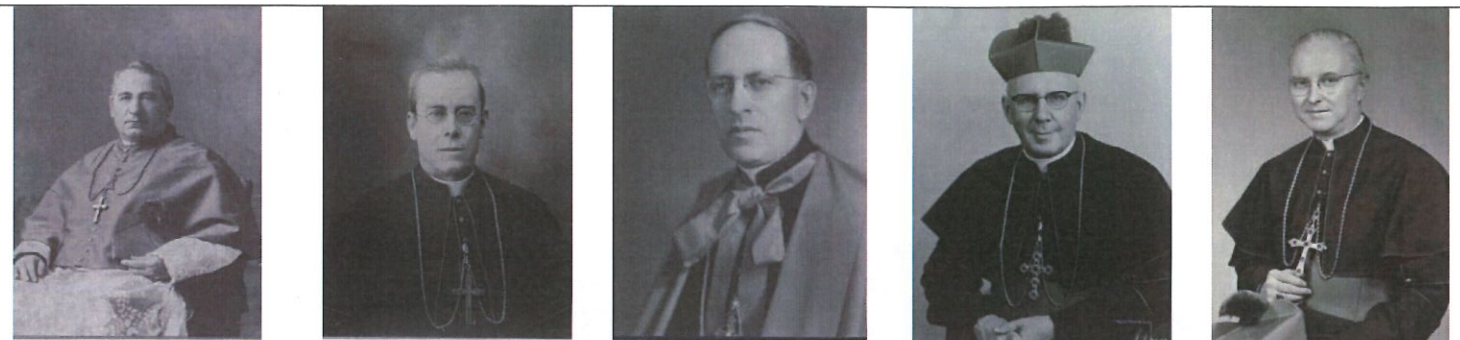

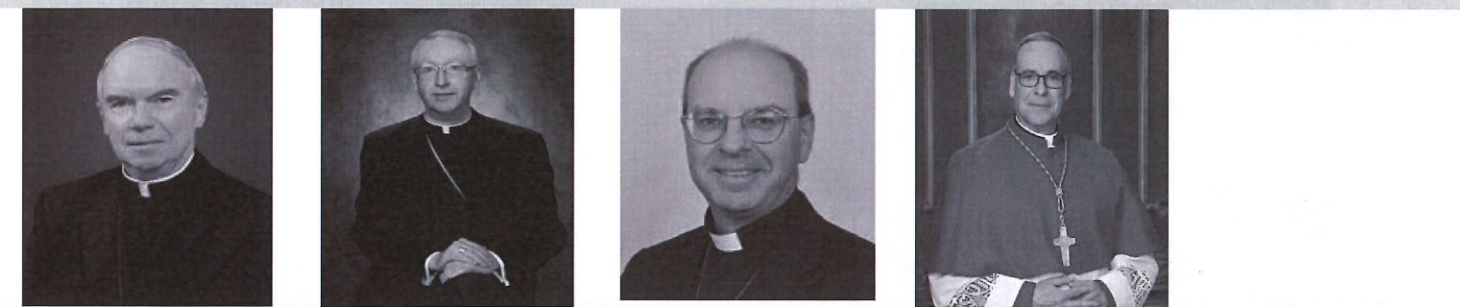

**WHAT IS A DIOCESE?** A diocese is a geographical territory within the Roman Catholic Church. You could say it is like a province in the country of Canada. Every diocese has a bishop, the successor to the Apostles, who governs, teaches, and sanctifies. The Diocese of Pembroke has had a total of 9 bishops including our current bishop, Guy Desrochers, since its foundation in 1898. Bishop Lorraine and Bishop Ryan died as bishop of Pembroke. Bishops Nelligan, W. J. Smith and Windle retired from being Bishop of Pembroke. Bishops O'Brien, R. W. Smith and Mulhall became Archbishops of another diocese. Dioceses are grouped together under a Metropolitan Archdiocese. Pembroke is grouped together with the Dioceses of Timmins and Hearst-Moosonee with the Archdiocese of Ottawa.
