

EVANGELIZATION AND THE MASS: In the documents for the Liturgy after the Vatican II Council, it was mentioned that the Blessed Sacrament could be in a chapel away from the main altar for private veneration. It had in mind the large churches or basilicas like St. Peter's in Rome where many tourists would distract from those wishing to pray to the Lord. It was never a directive that the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle be moved to the side in every Roman Catholic Church in the world. Unfortunately, somehow, this became a common conception and many churches saw the Blessed Sacrament removed from the centre altar (or behind the new altar). My thought is this: "how you treat something speaks to how you value it". If I have a picture painted by Van Gough, I do not hang in behind a door. It becomes a centre piece of my home and it shows how much I value it. Although there may not have been any malice on any individual priest or bishop's part, the moving of the tabernacle to the real presence. Bishop Desrochers wishes to have the tabernacle restored to the centre of the Cathedral and to have the bishop's cathedra (or chair) locate back to the side. I will work with the Parish Finance and Property Committee as well as with the Diocese and the Bishop to restore the tabernacle to the centre and to restore the Bishop's cathedral. More to come on this as things develop.
